It is with pride that we share our 2017 Annual Report that outlines the extensive support the Chemeketa Foundation receives for our students and programs at Chemeketa. We are thankful for you, our community of supporters, who play an essential role in furthering our mission of providing a quality education, removing financial barriers and preparing students for educational and career success.

In 2017, 2,260 students applied for Chemeketa Foundation scholarships and 648 scholarships were awarded. The cost of attending Chemeketa for one term (tuition, fees, books, rent, transportation, personal expenses, etc.) is \$5,534 and \$1,200 was our average annual scholarship award.

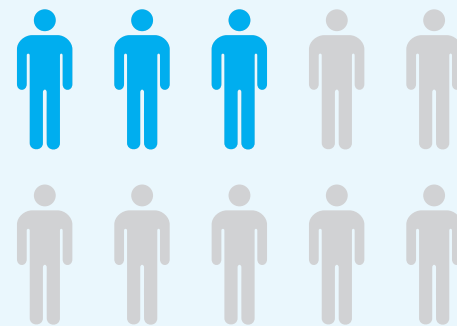

Because of the guidance I received, my plan is to become a high school teacher. I want to motivate

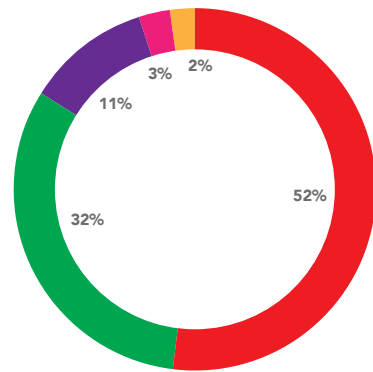

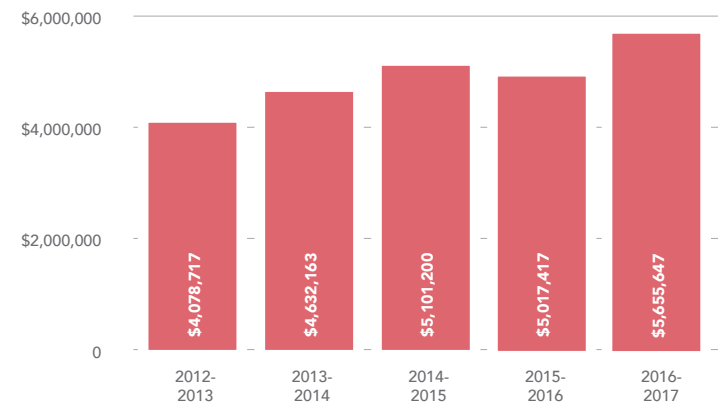

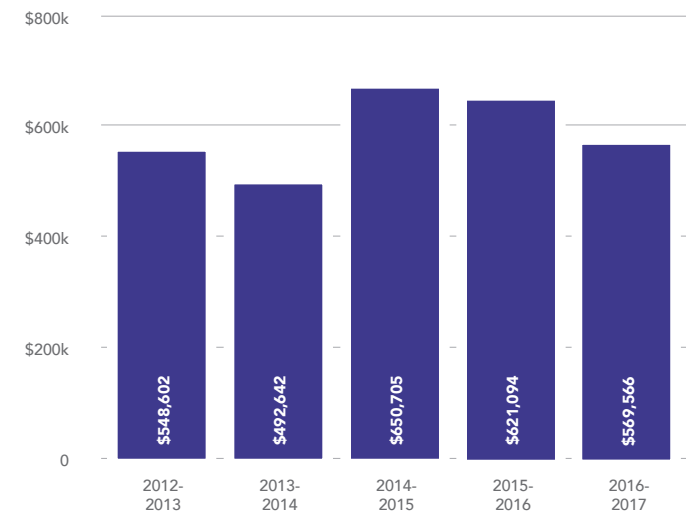

I didn't want my conditions to define me. Because I grew up in a broken home without mentorship, I want to become a corrections officer and provide juveniles with the skills they need to be successful. This award encourages me to remain humble..."

"The last grade that I completed before starting at Chemeketa was the sixth grade back in 1994. Last year, I decided to make a change. I was working at a call center full-time while studying for my GED. Within a couple of weeks, I was enrolled at Chemeketa and began working towards a degree for the first time. It didn't take long to realize how expensive going to school and raising three children as a single mom was. Not having been in school for nearly 20 years, I struggled my first term. I wanted to prove to myself that

I could do anything that I set my mind to. I never thought that I'd consistently make the honor roll, let alone complete a term of college algebra!

Receiving this scholarship has helped me to overcome some of the struggles of low self-esteem and adjusting to college life. Your support has made all the difference."

THE CASSY'S HOPE SCHOLARSHIP WAS ESTABLISHED BY FRIENDS AND FAMILY IN LOVING MEMORY OF CASSY HANSON AFTER HER DEATH IN THE MIDST OF HER COLLEGE JOURNEY. CASSY RE-DISCOVERED HER LOVE OF LEARNING AT CHEMEKETA COMMUNITY COLLEGE AT THE AGE OF 48, THEN WENT ON TO GRADUATE FROM WESTERN OREGON UNIVERSITY WITH A BACHELORS OF SCIENCE IN MATHEMATICS. CASSY WAS DIAGNOSED WITH CANCER ONLY MONTHS AFTER STARTING HER PH.D, AND PASSED AWAY AT THE AGE OF 54. HER SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORTS WOMEN OVER THE AGE OF 30 RETURNING TO SCHOOL AND ATTENDING COLLEGE FULL-TIME SEEKING A DEGREE OR CERTIFICATE.

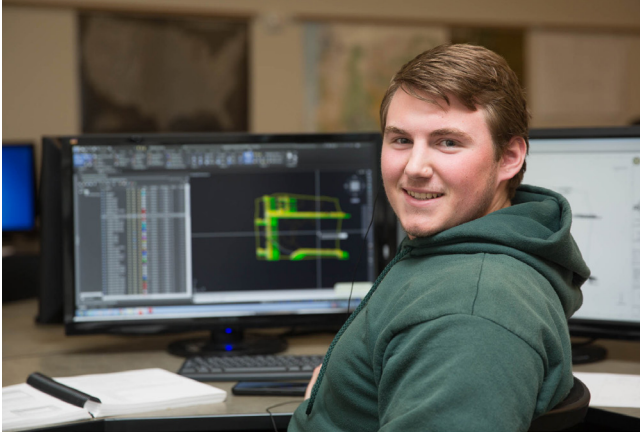
